Trail Information

What a difference from last year when we had several inches of snow by this time. This year we have very little snow on the ground with no significant snowfalls in the foreseeable forecast. But the lack of snow is actually a good thing and is allowing for everything to freeze up nicely, meaning that the groomers will be able to get out quicker once the snow does fall. Stay positive, the snow will come!!!

6 has been cleared and should be ready to go. Beavers have been active again this year. Slews appear to be freezing up nicely. Ice was approximately 8" thick on 12/18. We will still need to widen out sections to allow for the tractor to groom, however it is ready for the LMC and Bombardier.

5N (70 to Blaisdell): On 12/12, bales and drain tiles were set in place. After a couple more weeks of colder temps, then some snow, we should be able to see if our efforts paid off. Once all landowners have been contacted and current easements are signed we are hoping to have some major brushing completed. The Alliance may bring in a company to help us get this accomplished. We will need a crew to help with clean up once this is completed.

5S (Tower Rd to Rusk) The Alliance contracted a company to brush and widen Tower Rd to W. Most has been completed, however open water in areas has prolonged completeion. As of 12/19 this area appears to be freezing up nice and brushing should continue soon.

Missing signage was replaced on the Tuscobia from the Price County line to Couderay. Brushing was also completed.

As of 12/19 the lakes in the northern part of the County are reported as freezing up nicely, but are not quite ready to be staked.


